HUMATAK WATERSHED ADVENTURE

Embark on an exciting tour through the La Sa Fu'a Watershed in Humatak. The field trip begins on the hillsides of the upper watershed and culminates in Fouha Bay, the site of human creation according to Chamorro folklore. Scientific experts and cultural practitioners will meet participants at different stops along the adventure to discuss Guam's natural resources, watershed connections, and environmental threats. Participants will engage in a watershed restoration demonstration activity and learn how a community effort (www.humatakproject.org) prevented 112 tons of sediment from eroding off hillsides.
